



LEARN TE REO MĀORI

The University of Auckland's Puna Kōhungahunga, based at the Epsom Campus is offering a basic Reo Māori course to teachers, students, and the wider whānau. The course can be delivered completely online or delivered partly online with three evening face to face classes at the beginning, middle and end of the course. The course lasts for 9 weeks and has been designed for busy people, juggling work and/or study commitments. Registration costs also include a student workbook, weekly online tasks, and regular feedback about progress from an online tutor.

At the completion of this course, it is intended that students will be able to:

- greet, farewell, and acknowledge others
- introduce themselves by using personal information and place of family origin
- communicate about feelings, physical characteristics, amounts, actions, and locations
- use and respond to simple commands
- show progress in te reo Māori ability
- gain confidence to apply reo and tikanga Māori into the workplace
